Organizational Leaders

- Staff Coordinator** (21 years of age or older) – coordinates/supervises a group of 7-14 camp counselors.
- Logistics Coordinator** (21 years of age or older) – coordinates all of the travel and program logistics for a Volunteer Team.
- Supply Coordinator** Coordinates the purchasing and donations of arts and crafts supplies.
- Childcare Coordinator** (19 years of age or older) – coordinates and supervises all aspects of childcares services offered in conjunction with Camp Noah
- Recreational Coordinator** – coordinate all afternoon recreational activities and supplies needed.
- Arts and Craft Coordinator** – work with Camp Counselors to coordinate all afternoon craft activities & supplies needed.

Volunteer Specialists

- Camp Counselors** serve as a leader for 6-8 children/campers and works as a team member to carryout the majority of camp activities. Camp Counselors must be 18 years of age or older and post high school one year.
- Parish Nurses** (licensed in home state) provide a comfort corner and additional wellness and stress management activities in coordination with the Mental Health Professionals.
- Mental Health Professionals** (licensed) provide support to the volunteer teams through daily debriefings and support to campers on a group or individual basis as needed. Volunteer Mental Health Professionals will coordinate services with the local Mental Health Professional assigned to the camp.
- Chaplains/Pastors** (licensed) provide spiritual care and support to all participants through morning and evening devotions and informal support in visits throughout the day. They may facilitate group dialogue with a local Junior Counselor Group.

Support Volunteers

- Food Workers** serve with local volunteers in food preparation, service and cleanup for meals and snacks. Possess knowledge of basic cooking skills, with a willingness to learn cooking techniques for large numbers. Food Leaders must be at least 15 years old.
- Childcare Workers** work with the local volunteers to provide childcare for children before and/or after camp as needed. Childcare leaders must be at least fourteen years of age.
